We have had a lovely week in FS2. We have enjoyed being outside and have been exploring the mud kitchen, digging area and our new bird watching area.

As we are encouraging the children to think about recycling, composting and reducing landfill; the children have planted a tomato vine (now the crop is over), some paper & a plastic pot. We will dig these up at the end of term and see what has happened to them.

We have started our new phonics programme this week and the children have learnt the graphemes (symbol) s,a,t and p and their phoneme (sound). We have used our 'robot arms' to segment & blend simple words using these graphemes - such as p-a-t (pat), s-a-t (sat) etc. Please refer to the letter sent out last week explaining the new ELS.

In maths we have explored careful counting and making a two part pattern and in Understanding the World we have explored how we are all special and unique, looking at ourselves in a mirror and painting self portraits. We will continue with this next week.

In God's World we are exploring the creation story and within our Caritas learning we are thinking about our families at home and within our school community.
