Catholic Life of the School

We began our week with a big welcome back to school. It is lovely to see lots of happy children returning to school looking very smart in their school uniform.

On Monday, we listened to the Gospel of Matthew. Peter tells Jesus he cannot suffer and die. Jesus responds saying, 'Get away from me Satan!' The word 'Satan' literally meaning 'adversary' or 'enemy'. Jesus explains that is Peter's wish, not God's plan.

We spoke about how tricky it can be to trust in God's plan, but that like Peter, we too will make mistakes and they help us to learn. We shared some mistakes which had already happened – such as walking into the wrong classroom!

This week our mission is to share and delight in our little mistakes, knowing that St Peter the disciple made them too. Let us offer up all of our mistakes and learning at the start of this new school year.

Just a reminder to please ensure children do <u>not</u> play on the play equipment at the beginning or end of the day whilst unsupervised by school staff.




Being 15 minutes later each day is the same as missing 2 weeks of school
