

Matthew 18:15-20: '*If your brother wrongs you, go and take up the matter with him when the two of you are alone. If he listens to you, you have won your brother over.*' We spoke about the words and ways in which we might lovingly correct a friend to help them make the right choices and we considered if we were open to 'loving correction' from others which can sometimes be difficult to listen to.
