
Catholic Life of the School

School Meals Increase – Effective 1st April 2024

Regrettably, we have been notified by Herts Catering Limited that due to ever increasing costs they will be increasing their prices with effect from 1st April 2024. The cost of a universal infant meal (Reception, Y1 & Y2) will remain the same and is still free for all children in Receptions, Years 1 and 2. However, the cost of a Nursery meal will increase to £2.55 per day and the cost of a junior meal will increase to £3.40 per day.
